# Important Message

## Pool Opening

As many of you know, Palm Beach County authorized the opening of community pools. The county placed the following restrictions for the Association to open the pool:

1. Pool capacity shall be limited to ensure that social distancing in accordance with CDC Guidelines is maintained at all times.
2. Locker room and shower facilities shall remain closed. Restrooms shall be cleaned and disinfected regularly throughout the day. Soap and water or hand sanitizer and/or disinfectant wipes shall be provided in each restroom.
3. Pool deck meeting or lounging shall be restricted to ensure social distancing in accordance with CDC Guidelines.
4. One or more facility staff or management must be present at each facility location to monitor and ensure compliance with the restrictions within this order. Although restrictions #1, #3 and #4 can be accomplished with current staff, restriction #2 would require the Association to extend the hours of our cleaning personnel. This would impose additional costs to the Association. A \$500 a month increase to the cleaning costs, not including cleaning material, would only allow the pool to be open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Obviously, additional hours would incur additional costs. Weekends would not be possible due to the lack of management on Saturday and Sunday. Based on the current Palm Beach County current restrictions, it has been decided that the

Coco Wood Lakes pool will remain closed at this time. The situation will continue to be monitored and the pool will be opened as soon as it is economically and safely feasible to do so. Please note that, as of May 4, 2020, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis has not lifted restrictions in Palm Beach County. ## Garbage Container

With the use of the new SWA garbage container, it has become apparent that many of our residents are storing their container outside of the their homes in violation of the CWL Rules and Regulations. In an effort to address this situation, the Board will consider an amendment to the existing rules and regulations to allow the storage of the garbage container outside behind the frontlines of the house near the garage providing a four foot or higher natural screening is planted in front of the container storage area. As always, no fence material (wooden, pvc, etc.) will be permitted to be used. The recommended plant for the natural screening is Clusia but other plants can be used as long as they provide adequate screening.

## Lawn Watering

The South Florida Water Management District issued watering restrictions last month which few people are adhering to. The new watering restrictions limit watering to two days a week. Even addresses water on Thursday and Sunday. Odd addresses water on Wednesday and Saturday. Watering is only between 7pm to 7am.

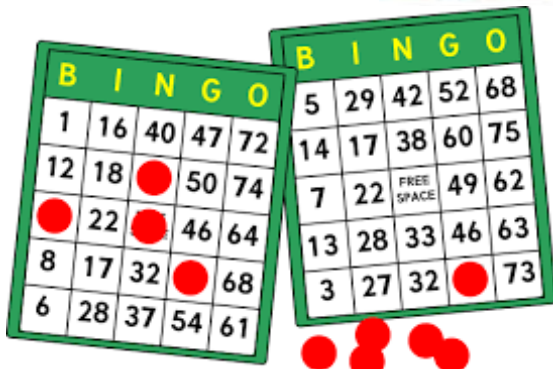
