

Board Highlights

November 23, 2020

The Board approved the air conditioners maintenance contract for 2021.

Vendor: Astro Air

Contract cost: \$1500

An election monitor was approved for the February election. The vendor is the same one used at last year's election.

Vendor: RMC

Contract cost: \$3500 (includes RMC monitoring as well as the anticipated cost for preparing the mailing of the first and second election notices.)

The 2021 Budget for CWL was passed. The approved budget results in no increase to the current maintenance fees which will remain at \$378 a quarter for non-lake homeowners and \$397 a quarter for lake homeowners. 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
